Course Overview

Enrollment Criteria

Students who would benefit from learning theoretical knowledge of traditional handicraft techniques. Students should be able to understand and comprehend creative expressions and techniques. Students who are interested can participate.

Engage and Assess

In the first weeks of the course, students will be assessed on their ability to comprehend the theoretical explanations and understanding of artistic creations. As the course progresses, teachers will guide the exploration of various forms of artistic expression to lay a solid foundation for the student's free and independent creation.

Explore and Develop

In the middle weeks of the course, students will explore the cultural connotations and artistic expressions of each craft, and reflect on their personal progress and refine their goals.

Refine and Present

In the final weeks of the course, students will be able to communicate and share their knowledge related to handicrafts, and have deeper appreciation of such works. They will also have the opportunity to see their own works being exhibited.

Parent Engagement Opportunity

Parents will be invited to attend the exhibition held at the end of each course. Parents will also be invited to participate in the course together during one lesson for each of the seven experiences. Parents need to collect students from MH Maker after lesson.
