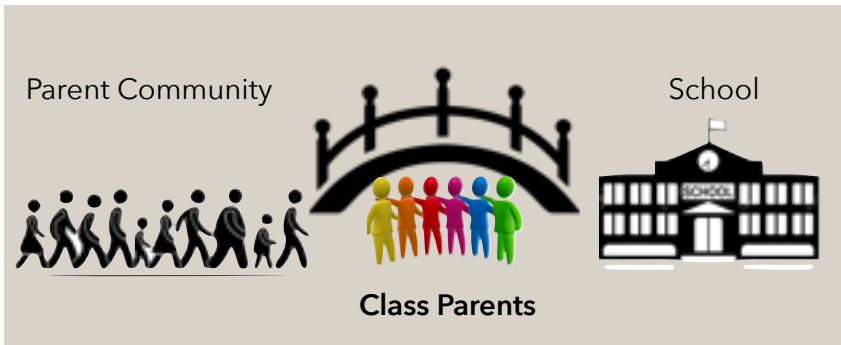

The Role of the Class Parents

Parent Engagement at BMH is both expected and appreciated. When all parents believe in the positive intentions of the school, and vice versa, and we work with the best interests of the students firmly at the heart of all our interactions and decisions, we will build lasting and constructive relationships that best facilitate the children's learning and well-being.

Class Parents at BMH act as advocates for the school. These parents act as a bridge between the wider parent community and the school - communicating majority ideas and questions to teachers, helping with the organisation of events and maintaining a positive approach.

The following table aims to clarify the role of the Class Parent and that of the wider parent community as well.

Class Parent Role	All Parents' Role
To model a positive attitude to school	To believe in the positive intent of BMH
To act as a positive communication bridge	To communicate respectfully
To support school procedures	To follow school procedures
To report problems and ask questions that represent the majority	To report and ask questions about individual problems
To support with organisation of events	To engage in events as required
